Over the past year we have had many changes in our Corps and in the Cadet program as a whole.

At the Corps level: We congratulated and said goodbye to our senior cadets, many of which had been with us for many years, as they finalized plans to attend University in places all over the world. Our staff had some changes as well. We said goodbye to a dedicated board member Mr. Jose Abundo. We wished our former Commanding Officer Capt Tim Townley and former Training Officer 2Lt Michael Azzano the best in their future endeavors as they move on to new opportunities.

We celebrated the promotion of our staff member, Capt Gordon Barrett, and welcomed him as our new Commanding Officer.

At the Regimental level: LCol Pierre Lajoie was welcomed as the new Commanding Officer and renovations within the building, including our offices, were completed.

As part of Minister of Defence's survey of the CAF it was determined that the Cadet program had room for improvement in many areas. The Army Cadet League of Canada continues to work the the Department of Defence to ensure the program is consistent. There has been changes to our standards, the curriculum, insurance policy and safety measures implemented.

Going forward all adults who volunteer with any Corps or Squadron in Canada must go through the Vulnerable Sector Screening check to ensure our youth are safe at all times. A simple Criminal Records Check and interview with the Board are required. All screened volunteers will have official identification provided to them.

The insurance policies were reviewed and updated at the national and provincial levels to include insurance for equipment and supplies owned by the Sponsoring Committee at the Corps level. This increase, unfortunately, is 3 times the amount we previously paid per cadet which takes up a large chunk of our budget. Much of our budget comes from parent donations and Cadet fundraising. We appreciate any and all donations from parents, community members or corporate sponsors. **We are required to offset this increase by asking <u>all parents</u> to provide a minimum donation of \$75**.

Parent involvement is vital to our program whether that is through donations, fundraising, networking or actively participating at events / activities. At the upcoming Annual General Meeting we will be discussing the changes further and making decisions regarding registration requirements for the coming years.
